Permanent identification may be: (a) registration papers, (b) a sketch or photo of a spotted animal, with birth date, dam and sire identification (form similar to old ID sheet), (c) freeze brand, (d) tattoo, or (e) ear tag.

Read and comply with *Wisconsin County, District, & State Fairs Animal Health Rules and Regulations* and *Jr. Dairy Cattle Department Requirements* which are found in the Oconto County Fair Premium List.
