



Hiking Challenge

Let's GO take a HIKE!

This challenge will prepare you for a Natural Resources & Environmental Education Project on hiking.

Challenge Instructions:

Step 1. Choose to create: a poster (14x22 stiff cardboard) or a scrapbook page (8 1/2 X11 or 12 x 12)

Step 2. Select 10 or more items necessary for your hike.

- footwear (closed toe shoes or boots that offer support) & thick socks
- weather protection (sun, wind, rain) layers of clothing (temperature)
- maps, compass, GPS, and phones to plan your route (consider if electronic devices will function in your chosen location. Also consider how long your hike should take (distance, terrain, & pace)
- emergency contact information (dog tags, note card with names & phone #)
- first aid supplies, food (light weight/high protein snacks) & water
